Submission Guidelines

Articles

You are encouraged to submit articles on the success of your various environmental health care initiatives. These can include, but are not limited to, news stories about the energy awards you have won, the environmental research papers you have written, the energy efficiency publications you have produced, your in-house and collaborative energy awareness and environmental initiatives, and any energy retrofit projects you have undertaken.

Articles should include reference to your membership in the Energy Innovators Initiative (now known as Energuide for Existing Buildings) and, if applicable, your involvement in the Canadian College of Health Service Executives or the Canadian Coalition for Green Health Care. Please describe what the benefits are to your organization and to the environment.

Please submit your full contact information including name, telephone number, e-mail address and organization affiliation.

Articles should be between 300 and 500 words. An accompanying photograph is encouraged. Illustrations, if included, should follow digital technical requirements below. Captions are required for all submitted images and illustrations. We cannot guarantee publication of articles within any given time frame. All text should be checked for punctuation, spelling and grammar before being submitted.

Technical requirements

Digital: All images should be 300 dpi for a maximum final print size of 5" x 7" in JPEG or TIFF format. Before e-mailing files over 500 KB, please contact the editor at kwaddington@cchse.org.

Text: All text should be in *Microsoft Word* or contained within the body of an e-mail. Please DO NOT imbed any images in the e-mail or *Word* document.
